
# 1. Language setting

You can change to the language mode in N-Designer, N-Show program. An object, such as a button or text output, you can also set the language mode. You can also edit the language mode to add an unregistered language.



## 1.1. N-Designer Set menu language

You can set the N-Designer language settings by clicking [Start Menu] and clicking the option menu.



You can set the language in [Language Menu - Code].




① en-US : English


② ko-KR: Korean



After setting up ko-KR, quit N-Designer and re-execute. All the characters in the menu will be set to Korean.




After En-US is set, after N-Designer is closed and re-executed, the characters in all menus are set to English.






## 1.2. N-Designer Object language setting

In the left pane of the Project Explorer, double-click Properties.



The Project Settings window appears and click [Language].




- ① You can edit the text of object such as button, text output in English.
- 2) You can edit the text of the object such as button, text output in Korean.
- 3 Click the Add button to register another language.
- 4 You can set and register the language of various objects in the open menu of editor.




### 1.2.1. Open editor

You can register languages for each object by clicking Open Editor. The types of the editor menu consist of import, export, add, and delete.




#### 1.2.1.1. Import

You can import the exported file into the language editor list by clicking the [Import icon].






When you click [Import Icon], the Load Data pop-up window appears and click the OK button.




Select the xml file you just exported and click the Open button.






When you click the Open button, the imported file is output to the list.






#### 1.2.1.2. Export

You can click [Export Icon] to export the list set in the language editor to an xml file.




When you click [Export Icon], the data view window appears and click the Save button to save the file in xml format in the corresponding path.






Exporting You can open an xml file in Excel and edit the file.



#### 1.2.1.3. Add

You can add a language edit list by clicking [Add icon].


You can modify the input name by double-clicking Description, en-US, ko-KR.

Click the row you want to delete and click **X** [Delete icon] to delete the selected row.






#### Selected row deleted.






# 1.3. Check language settings after publishing

You can check what you set in the Language Editor in the N-Show program. You can change the language setting in the Publish menu, N-Show program.




After creating three buttons, enter "button", "change color", "report output" respectively.





## 1.3.1. Publish menu


On the Publish menu [File - Default Language], set the language and click the Next button to complete the publication.






## 1.3.2. N-Show program

On the Publish menu [File - Default Language], set the language and click the Next button to complete the publication.




Click [Show - Settings] to display the main menu and language menu.




You can change the language setting in [Language - Code].
